2019 PONTIAC STREETS PAVING PROGRAM
MILL STREET

The City of Pontiac will begin the first phase of the reconstruction (removing pavement, spot locations of curb and gutter and sidewalk, excavating underlying soils and placing new aggregate base where necessary) of MILL STREET in your area within the next few days. This street improvement program is being constructed at no cost to the adjacent owners.

Cadillac Asphalt, LLC. has been awarded the contract for the street construction. Nowak & Fraus, Consulting Engineer for the City of Pontiac, will monitor all work.



MILL STREET WILL BE COMPLETELY CLOSED FROM UNIVERSITY TO HURON FOR THE DURATION OF THE WORK. Periodic lane closures on University Drive and Perry Street may be required during construction.
