If you are a renter, violations are sent to your house, if they are not rectified, and your lease information is not on record, tickets are then sent to the owner of the property. **122-71 Dense noxious growth prohibited on the front lawns (b)** On private property no turf grass shall be permitted at a height greater than 8 inches. Is another ordinance of that nature.

****** We now have a Bulk Pickup for household items.**

In September Advanced Waste started picking up in a Bulk fashion regularly, you no longer need to call, to have items picked up, you simply place them on the curb the night before you trash day every other week. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday trash days are picked up the 1st and 3rd week of the month.
