What Happened?

Due to emergency water system maintenance in your neighborhood, your property may be temporarily without water service.

What this Means to You:

Whenever a water system loses pressure, there is a potential for pollutants to enter the system. At this time, **no actual contamination has been detected** within the water system. However, as a precautionary measure, all water customers in the affected area are advised to boil all water used for drinking and cooking. Drinking water should be boiled for at least five minutes and allowed to cool before consumption. An alternative is to use bottled water for drinking and cooking.

Once the water sample test results are in compliance with Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) guidelines, you will be notified that the **Precautionary Boil Water Notice** has ended.
