What is Happening?

Due to a scheduled water main repair in your neighborhood, your property may experience an interruption of water service on **TUESDAY MARCH 13, 2018** between **8:00 am THRU 8:00 pm**.

What this Means to You:

Whenever a water system loses pressure, there is a potential for pollutants to enter the system. **Starting TUESDAY MARCH 13, 2018**, as a precautionary measure, all water customers in the affected area are advised to boil water used for drinking and cooking **until this notice has been rescinded**. Drinking water should be boiled at least five minutes and allowed to cool before consumption. An alternative is to use bottled water for drinking and cooking.

Once the water sample test results are in compliance with Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) guidelines, you will be notified that the **Precautionary Boil Water Notice** has ended.
